- A preliminary round competition will be held in the school on a weekday evening during the last week of November, prior to Thanksgiving (date to be finalized), from 5 – 7 p.m. A parent must accompany each child. Ten finalists will be selected.
- Preliminary rounds will be scored based on the total number of correct answers.
 A moderator will ask questions and students will answer verbally.
- The ten selected finalists will take part in a final competition, which will be held in the school during the second week of January. If your child is selected to participate, he/she will be sent home with further instructions. The school champion will need to take a written test in order to qualify for the state competition (held in April) and national competition (held in May).
