 - During the period November 9-20, fourth through sixth grade classrooms will hold a classroom geography test conducted by their classroom teacher. The top ten scoring finalists will be selected from across all classrooms.
 - The ten selected finalists will take part in a final competition, which will be held in the school during the second or third week of January. If your child is selected to participate, he/she will be sent home with further instructions. The school champion will need to take a written test in order to qualify for the state competition (held in April) and national competition (held in May).
