Mondays

PE CLUB WITH MR. DOWLING: (Grades 4-6) Students will participate in various intramural sport (such as basketball, floor hockey, soccer, badminton, and other modified skill-themed games) and fitness-related activities with an emphasis on skill development, game strategies, team work, and sportsmanship as well as health and fitness. **MORNINGS** 8:15-9:15 a.m.; Min. 10 – Max 35. FLAG FOOTBALL with Overtime Athletics: (Grades 2-5) Huddle up and get ready for Flag Football to become an instant classic. Learn to pass, catch, run routes and punt like the pros! We'll practice these skills while playing Button Hook, Down & Out, Pitch & Run, and First & Ten. Students will learn to define and analyze the mechanics of player experiences of their games. Students will learn how to be a game designer, design narratives, learn to apply art and animation, programming roles, project teamwork, hardware and game platforms, and how to make a game from beginning to end. This class is designed for students who are looking for WeDo robotics challenges and is appropriate for younger children newer to robotics. The course emphasizes creative problem-solving challenges, design innovation, and basic applied math concepts. Coached by avid runner and marathoner, Ms. Lynch, this co-ed running program for grades 2-6 will participate in weekly group runs, increasing the distance over the course of the program, all while learning about pacing, nutrition, and goal setting. The PTA uses an online-only system for registration and payment, called Pay4SchoolStuffOnline. To use this system:

- 1. Go to www.pay4schoolstuff.com. If you have already created an account and entered each student, skip to step 6.
- 2. Under the "Parents" tab, click on the "Get Started Now" button.
- 3. On the first screen, enter your contact information.
- 4. On the second screen, add your student, assign him/her to Freedom Hill Elem., and select his/her grade.
- 5. Repeat step 4 to add additional students to your account.
- 6. To see the options available for purchase, including Spring 2017 enrichment programs, SELECT the student by name.
- 7. Add the desired enrichment program(s) to your cart. You will be required to fill out contact information for **each** program that you register for.
- 8. At checkout, use any major credit card or debit card to complete your purchase.
- 9. You will receive a confirmation email from www.pay4schoolstuff.com after payment is complete. If you do not receive an email, your registration did not go through. Please check your SPAM folder, then re-register if needed.

Please note—you must register each child separately. You will be able to see how many spots are still available for each class. Once a class fills up, a waitlist will be created. **Don't procrastinate—some classes fill quickly!**

Refunds (less a \$15 processing fee) are available before a class begins, assuming we still have enough students to go forward with the class. No refunds will be offered once a class begins.
