PE CLUB with Mr. Dowling: (Grades 4-6) Students will participate in various intramural sport (such as basketball, floor hockey, soccer, badminton, and other modified skill-themed games) and fitness-related activities with an emphasis on skill development, game strategies, teamwork, and sportsmanship as well as health and fitness. **MORNINGS** 8:15-9:15 a.m.; Min. 8 – Max 30. STEM Fun K-1 with STEMexCEL: (Grades K-1) This is the perfect course for young students to learn about technology in a fun way! Students will be introduced to a range of activities including programming, game design, Minecraft modding, electronics, digital art, and 3D printing! STEMexCEL instructors have been especially trained to educate this age group and will be able to offer strong support for little learners. RUN CLUB with Kids in Motion: (Grades K-6) Students learn the fundamentals of walking for exercise, power walking, jogging, running, and sprinting so they can learn to pace themselves and run further each week. Coaches engage the kids in fun running warm ups, such as sharks and minnows, tag games, and team racing competitions. During running time, they track their distance at the completion of each lap and work toward new goals each class. At the end of the each class coaches and kids stretch together, go over their distance they achieved that day, and set their distance goal for the next class. LEGO ROBOTICS with STEMexCEL: (Grades 2-6) STEMexCEL Lego Robotics is designed for students looking to get started with robotics and those who are possibly interested in learning competitive robotics. In this course, students learn how to design, build, and program Lego Mindstorms EV3 robots by constructing and programming a robot. By applying engineering concepts as well as advanced sensor programming skills, students will perfect their design and programming to solve a variety of challenges. The PTA uses an online-only system for registration and payment, called Pay4SchoolStuffOnline. To use this system:

1. Go to www.pay4schoolstuff.com. If you have already created an account and entered each student, skip to step 6.
2. Under the "Parents" tab, click on the "Get Started Now" button.
3. On the first screen, enter your contact information.
4. On the second screen, add your student, assign him/her to Freedom Hill Elem., and select his/her grade.
5. Repeat step 4 to add additional students to your account.
6. To see the options available for purchase, including Spring 2018 enrichment programs, SELECT the student by name.
7. Add the desired enrichment program(s) to your cart. You will be required to fill out contact information for **each** program that you register for.
8. At checkout, use any major credit card or debit card to complete your purchase.
9. **You will receive a confirmation email from www.pay4schoolstuff.com after payment is complete. If you do not receive an email, your registration did not go through. Please check your SPAM folder, then re-register if needed.**

Please note—you must register each child separately. You will be able to see how many spots are still available for each class. Once a class fills up, a waitlist will be created. **Don't procrastinate—some classes fill quickly!**

Refunds (less a **\$20 processing fee**) are available before a class begins, assuming we still have enough students to go forward with the class. No refunds will be offered once a class begins.
